**Medicare Part B accepted for flu shots.** Medicare Part B will be accepted for pneumonia shots provided it is the first shot. You **MUST** bring your Medicare card. (Flu shots are recommended every year.)

**Medicaid** will **ONLY** be accepted for flu and pneumonia shots done at the City of Casper-Natrona County Health Department. Medicaid does not reimburse for shots done at a public clinic.

**Children 6 months – 12 years old must come to the Health Department to receive their flu shot.**

**Children 6 months – 9 years old who have never received a previous flu vaccination need to receive 2 vaccinations ≥ 4 weeks apart.**
