

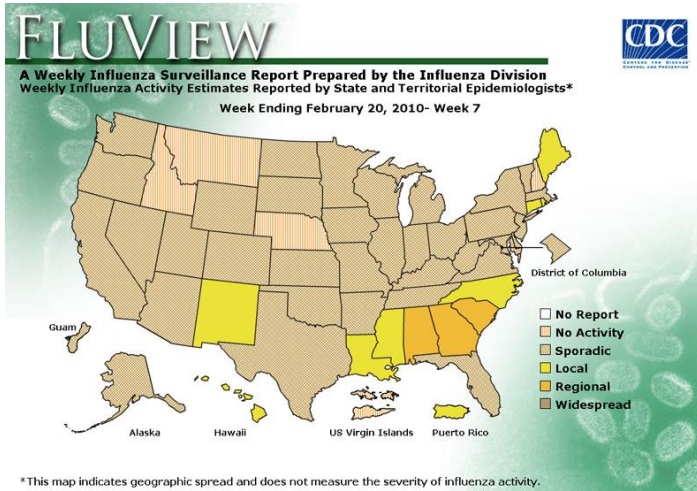

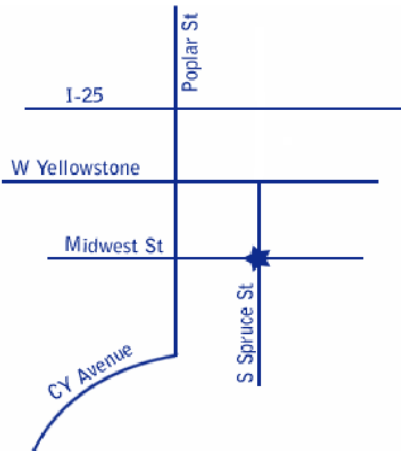
→ Wyoming is showing sporadic activity of influenza
